

(4) Application Requirements (details)

Application requirements differ depending on the application method. Please prepare your application after carefully checking the “Application Requirements” listed in the application guidelines.

Applicants who have scholastic qualifications equal to or more than those of a high school graduate as stipulated in Article 150 of the School Education Act Enforcement Regulations should confirm the relevant information before applying.

“Applicants who have scholastic qualifications equivalent to a high school graduate as stipulated in Article 150 of the School Education Act Enforcement Regulations, or have scholastic qualifications equal to or more than those qualifications,” as detailed under qualification requirements are applicants who fall under any of the below, or who expect to fall under any of the below by the time of enrollment:

1 Applicants who have completed 12 years of education*, or the equivalent which meets standards set by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, in an educational institution overseas (applicants who have equivalent qualifications to those who have completed 12 years of education in an educational institution overseas as stipulated in Article 153 of the 1981 School Education Act Enforcement Regulations).

* This includes cases where a student has graduated from a normal course in under 12 years due to grade skipping and early graduation.

2 Applicants who have completed a course of study at an overseas educational institution. Overseas education institutions are schools that are recognized or designated as having the educational standards of a Japanese high school, or which are equivalent to Japanese high school, or meet educational standards set by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology. Not all schools located overseas fall under this category.

3 Applicants who have completed an advanced course (limited to courses of 3 years or more, and must satisfy other standards set by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) at a vocational school, which meets the standards set by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology after the date set by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.

4 Applicants who meet the standards set by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
(Applicants who have scholastic qualifications equivalent to a high school graduate, or knowledge that is equivalent or higher, as stipulated in Article 47 of the 1948 School Education Act Enforcement Regulations)

5 Applicants who are 18 years of age or older and have passed the Certificate for Students Achieving the Proficiency Level of Upper Secondary School Graduates or University Entrance Qualification.

6 Applicants who are 18 years of age or older and recognized by Hosei University as having scholastic ability equivalent to or higher than that of a high school graduate.
